



3-WEEK COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSE (CDL) TRAINING



This 3-week class consists of 4 days of classroom training and 11 days behind-the-wheel/vehicle training, and is intended to provide basic skills for drivers in the construction industry where much of the driving is off road. On road skills are also taught, and the CDL test is administered on the road.



- **Equipment:** Class A & B CDL Trucks and Trailers
- **Certifications:** Class A CDL
- **Prerequisites:**
 - Be at least 19 years of age**
 - Have a clean driving record** (for the past 2 years)
 - Provide a DMV full (10 year) driver history** (obtained no more than 30 days prior to training)
 - Pass a DOT physical** (physical is usually valid for 2 years)
 - Pass a DOT drug test** (cannot be done more than 10 days prior to training start date)
 - Provide a copy of AK Driver's license** (valid Class D license for a minimum of ONE year)
 - Provide a copy of Social Security card** (or verification letter from social security administration)
